

# International Student Advisory Board

## Terms of Reference



### **Purpose**

The purpose of the International Student Advisory Board is to improve the accessibility of LUU and campus wide services for the benefit of all international students at the University of Leeds. The International Student Advisory Board will do this by considering current work and future plans in this area, and by sharing recommendations and making suggestions based on their shared expertise and personal experiences.

### **Membership**

The Advisory Board will be composed of 30 members, who will be appointed following an application process.

The Advisory Board will include students from various faculties, study levels and nationalities.

The Board will be chaired by the International Officer, Franks Feng, and supported by the International Student Engagement Coordinator, Katharine Missin.

### **Remit**

The Advisory Board will

- Consider current activity in this area at LUU and share any recommendations
- Review future plans in this area and give constructive feedback
- Request any additional information needed to make recommendations about activity
- Propose new areas of Union Policy and champion these at Better Forum
- Act as a 'critical friend' to LUU teams and leadership
- Give feedback with the whole student body in mind, but share that feedback on the basis of their personal and individual knowledge and experience
