FIRST THINGS FIRST – LET'S GET OUR FACTS STRAIGHT

What are the reasons I can appeal?

- Mitigating circumstances (e.g. an illness, and you had a good reason for not telling your School at the time)
- Previously disclosed mitigating circumstances that haven't been taken into account
- An unfair or biased assessment
- A procedural error

What can I appeal?

- Your degree classification (e.g. 2:1, 2:2 etc)
- A mark on a piece of assessed work
- A reassessment opportunity
- The decision to not award you a degree
- The decision to not allow you to progress with your course
